


The urban setting, made with acrylic paint, stamps and collage, gives it a singular beauty.




ROUND AND ROUND





APARTMENT FOR RENT

Lea Goldberg • Eva Sánchez

This fable has become an Israeli children's literary classic. Based on a traditional Western European tale, Apartment for rent, has a simple and profound message: it is wise and to be tolerant with one's neighbors.

It begins with the description of the tenants in a building: a plump hen, a cuckoo bird, a coquettish cat, and a ravenous squirrel. The fifth floor used to belong to Mr. Mouse, but he has disappeared. The neighbors hang a sign that reads "Apartment for rent". Who will the future tenant be?

Eva Sánchez Gómez' warm illustrations make this classic fable fresh and current. Today it goes beyond its borders to convey a message: peace and tolerance is up to each and every one of us. It is a book for the times we live in, where there is less and less willingness to understand others.
